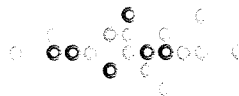



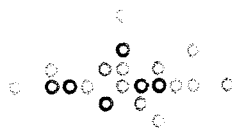

Notice of temporary reduction of operations

Dear Ms Dortch:

In accordance with 47 CFR 73.561 (d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of KCCD-FM, Moorhead, MN, hereby informs the Commission that as of August 18, 2009, KCCD will be operating at about 50% of authorized power and is expected to either be off the air or operating at a reduced power for at least a few weeks. Storm damage caused damage to the antenna system of KCCM, which is on the same tower. Due to the damage to KCCM, KCCD cannot operate at full power until KCCM is back on the air at full power with a replacement antenna.

All reasonable efforts will be made to replace the damaged KCCM equipment and to get both stations back up to their authorized power as soon as possible once the full extent of the damage is determined and new equipment can be ordered and placed on the tower.


