Dear Ms Dortch:

Minnesota Public Radio (MPR) has been granted Special Temporary Authority for K237ET to be off the air temporarily. At the time the STA request was filed, MPR informed the Commission that it had lost its tower site but had applied for and received a construction permit to build at a different site (see attached Notice of Suspension of Operations/Request for Silent STA, FCC file BLSTA-20091112AES.) The STA, a copy of which is attached to this letter, expires October 29, 2010.

The Construction Permit referred to in the above silent request (BPFT-20090608ACD), a copy of which is also attached to this letter, states in Special operating conditions or restriction #1 that "upon resumption of broadcasting, the licensee must notify the Commission by letter....". On June 15, 2010, MPR filed a Form 350 requesting a license pursuant to this CP.

Thus, in accordance with the above Construction Permit Special Operating condition, and the above described STA, MPR hereby notifies the Commission that as of June 17, 2010, K237ET is now back on the air.

MPR is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore, no fee is required for this filing.

Dear Mr. Kigin:

This letter concerns your request, filed on November 12, 2009, on behalf of Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR") for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K237ET to remain silent.

MPR's request states that K237ET went silent on October 28, 2009, due to the loss of the tower lease. MPR's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

MPR's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit FM Translator Station K237ET to remain silent for a period not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for K237ET will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. October 29, 2010.**² See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).


