KCRB-FM is now back up to full power.

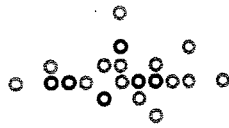
An Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification form is attached. MPR is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore, no fee is required for this filing.

Dear Ms Dortch:

In accordance with 47 CFR 73.561 (d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of KCRB-FM, Bemidji, MN, hereby informs the Commission that MPR has temporarily been operating KCRB-FM at reduced power since November 29, 2005 due to icing of the antenna. MPR is currently operating the facility at 20% of authorized power. We will be able to operate back at full power once the weather warms sufficiently for the ice to melt. It is unusual for a cold snap of this nature to last this long and we hope there is a warm-up soon.

An Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification form is attached. MPR is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore, no fee is required for this filing.
