Minnesota Public Radio hereby gives public notice that on November 30, 2012, it filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission seeking to renew its license to operate FM translator station K277AD, which is located at 43° 40' 13" N Latitude and 92° 58' 37" W Longitude and serves Austin, MN. The station operates on channel 277 at a power of 0.100 kW.

The station engages in the rebroadcasting of KLSE, Rochester, MN on channel 214. Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the Commission by March 1, 2013.

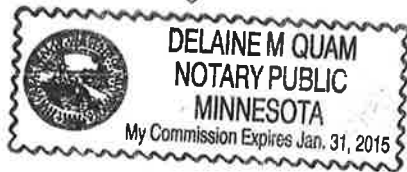
