On September 15, 2009, Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), the licensee of KRSU, filed a request for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to operate at approximately 5% of its authorized power. According to the FCC's database, an STA was granted on September 16, 2009.

As of September 21, 2009, KRSU is back on the air at its authorized power.
