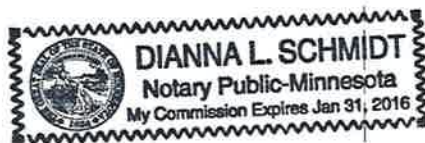

Minnesota Public Radio hereby gives public notice that on November 28, 2012, it filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission seeking to renew its license to operate FM translator station K280EC, which is located at 44° 5' 19" N Latitude and 93° 8' 25" W Longitude and serves Owatonna, MN. The station operates on channel 280 at a power of 0.205 kW.

The station engages in the rebroadcasting of KNGA, St. Peter, MN on channel 213.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application and to whether this station has operated in the public interest should file comments and petitions with the Commission by March 1, 2013.

Further information concerning the FCC's broadcast license renewal process may be obtained from the FCC, Washington, D.C. 20554.


