On behalf of Minnesota Public Radio, licensee of KNOW-FM, I am writing to request a one (1) year extension of the experimental broadcast authorization granted on October 7, 2005 pursuant to Section 73.1510 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Sec. 73.1510. In anticipation of the Commission's permanent authorization of digital radio multicasting, the station is continuing to transmit a hybrid digital signal incorporating multiple digital audio channel as part of iBiquity Digital Corporation's In-Band On-Channel (IBOC) digital transmission system for FM broadcasting.


Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification
