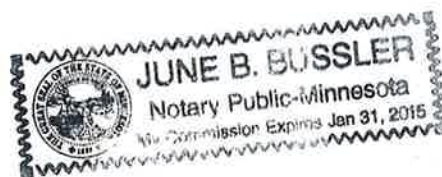

Minnesota Public Radio hereby gives public notice that on November 28, 2012, it filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission seeking to renew its license to operate FM translator station K286AU, which is located at 44°44'37" N Latitude and 94°23'36" W Longitude and serves Glencoe, MN. The station operates on channel 286 at a power of 0.115 kW.

The station engages in the re-broadcasting of KNSR, Collegeville, MN on channel 205.
