On November 13, 2007 in accordance with 47 CFR 73.1560(d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of KQMN, Thief River Falls, MN, informed the Commission that MPR had temporarily and voluntarily decreased the power of KQMN by 50% on November 2, 2007 due to the failure of the HD injector that was being installed for the installation of HD radio. A copy of that notice is enclosed with this letter.

As it turns out, the station was returned to operating at its full authorized power on November 14, 2007.

Dear Ms Dortch:

In accordance with 47 CFR 73.1560(d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of KQMN, Thief River Falls, MN, hereby informs the Commission that MPR temporarily and voluntarily decreased the power of KQMN by 50% on November 2, 2007 due to the failure of the HD injector that was being installed for the installation of HD radio. The manufacturer of the HD injector has been contacted and is expected to immediately ship a replacement injector. We are hopeful that the injector will be in place within the next 30 days and that it will allow MPR to return KQMN to full power.
