On October 16, 2007, Minnesota Public Radio filed an application with the Federal Communications Commission for authority to construct a new full service noncommercial FM educational broadcast station to operate on channel 201. The application seeks authority to construct a class A FM station operating at 2.1 kilowatts, with the transmitter located at Redwood Falls, MN, and an antenna measuring 93.6 meters. Studios will be located at Minneapolis/St. Paul, MN.


