Dear Ms Dortch:

In accordance with 47 CFR 73.561 (d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of KRSW-FM, Worthington, MN, hereby informs the Commission that MPR has temporarily been operating KRSW-FM at reduced power since March 7, 2005 due to repair work being done on the antenna. MPR is currently operating the facility at 10% of authorized power.

We expect to have this facility up to full power within 30 days of March 7th.

An Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification form is attached. MPR is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore, no fee is required for this filing.
