In accordance with 47 CFR 73.561 (d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of KWRV-FM, Sun Valley, ID, on March 26, 2007 MPR informed the Commission that MPR had temporarily been operating KWRV-FM at reduced power since March 16 due to a failure of the power amplifier in the transmitter. All repair work has been completed and the station resumed normal operations on April 10, 2007.

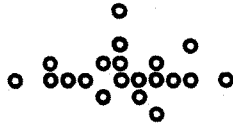
